Our Students

Master in Public Policy (MPP)

MPP students undertake a two-year, full-time programme focused on policy analysis and technical skills. The cohort consists of young professionals with between two and five years of work experience in the public, private, and not-for-profit sectors.

Master in Public Administration (MPA)

MPA students are in a one-year, full-time programme with a focus on decision-making and leadership skills. The cohort consists of mid-careerists who have held a supervisory role and have at least six years of work experience.

Master in International Affairs (MIA)

MIA students pursue a two-year, full-time programme to familiarise themselves with theoretical frameworks and practical knowledge for the international relations field. Students have a keen interest in global and Asian affairs, with good undergraduate degrees from diverse backgrounds.

Your organisation can advertise open positions on the LKY School Job & Internship Portal, which is a free online job posting and internship resource utilised by our students and alumni. To submit an internship or job opportunity to our portal, please contact Career Services.

Guidelines for Hiring International Students

Full-time international students of the National University of Singapore (this includes the LKY School) who hold a valid Student Pass are allowed to work up to 16 hours per week during the semester, or full time during the vacation period. No other employment passes are needed for work or internships based in Singapore.

This, however, does not apply to students who are on exchange programmes or whose Student Passes are valid for less than six months. Please check the Ministry of Manpower website (www.mom.gov.sg) for the latest manpower guidelines.





Networking Events and Industry Nights

On-Campus Interviews/Video Interviews

Career Services provides training to help students hone their interviewing skills by conducting mock interviews whereby students can get to role play (as interviewees) with industry professionals (as interviewers) in a simulated environment. Organisations who may appreciate the opportunity to engage with our graduating students can do so by participating in these mock interviews.



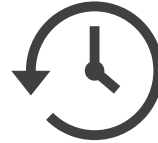
Internships

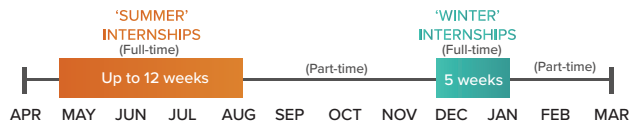
