Dr. Ishani Mukherjee, PhD Sustainability Practice Lead at Global Counsel Research Fellow at the Institute of Water Policy and LKYSPP, Singapore

Ishani Mukherjee's expertise include environmental and natural resource policy and management. She was the recipient of the World Future Foundation PhD Prize for Environmental and Sustainability Research in 2014. Widely published and awarded, her research interests combine policy design and formulation, with a thematic focus on policy instruments for environmental sustainability, renewable energy and energy efficiency, particularly in Southeast Asia. Previously, she has worked at the World Bank's Energy practice in Washington, DC, on formulating guidelines and evaluating projects related to renewable energy, rural electrification and energy efficiency. She obtained her B.Sc and M.Sc degrees in Natural Resources and Environmental Economics from Cornell University and received PhD in Public Policy from the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, with a focus on Environmental Policy.
