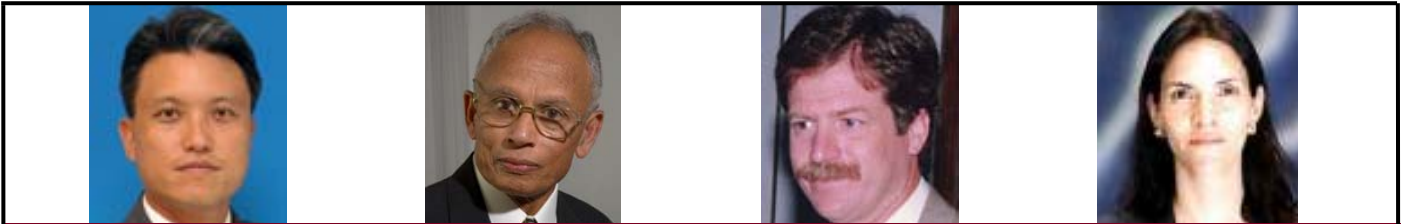

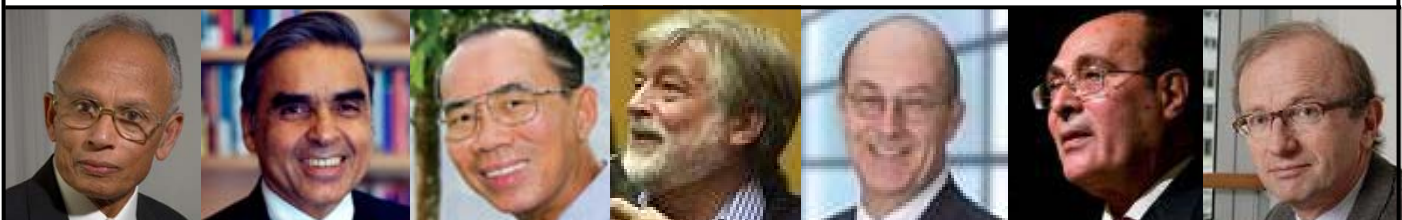

Overview of the Water Policy Dialogue:

As PUB Singapore's strategic partner for Singapore International Water Week 2009, the Institute of Water Policy is hosting the inaugural "Water Policy Dialogue" on 25 June 2009 at the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy. It aims to convene water leaders around the world to discuss the achievements and challenges in water management.

The Dialogue opens with the **Malhaar Concerto**, composed by visionary musician, composer, music educator and writer - Prof. Kanniks Kannikeswaran, to highlight the special place accorded to water resources in the ancient traditions and its relevance to today's globalised world. As part of the Dialogue, the **Workshop on Water Governance (9.00am to 11.00am)**, conducted by Prof. Asit K. Biswas, Distinguished Visiting Professor, Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy and President, Third World Water Centre for Water Management, Mexico; proposes to expose participants to current issues in water sector leadership and management.
