





### Quick steps on investment process





#### Phase 2

- Application for Investment Registration Certificate (IRC) from DPI
- Evidence on meeting requirement on legal capital may be required for conditional businesses
  - Estimated 15 days for general projects
  - Estimated 40 days for projects which lease state land
  - Estimated 60 days for major projects which require Investment In-Principle Approval from Prime Minister



#### Phase 4

Open capital and operating bank account for business commencement





#### Phase 1

Prepare required documentation for application on investment license from the Provincial Department of Planning and Investment (DPI) or Management Board of Industrial Zones

- Legal documents of parent company (i.e.: business license, incorporation certificate, company charter, financial statements, etc.)
- Legal documents of key personnel
- Lease agreement



#### Phase 3

Application for Enterprise **Registration Certificate** (ERC) from DPI

#### **CIT Incentives**

- Incentives granted are based on regulated encouraged sectors, locations and size.
- Incentives (preferential CIT rate) may vary from 10% to 17% and last for 10 years, 15 years or the whole investment period.


#### **CIT Incentives for Large Manufacturing Projects**

- CIT rate of 10 per cent applicable for 15 years.
- Large manufacturing projects with investment capital of at least VND 6,000 billion being disbursed within 3 years from the date of investment licensing, and no later than 3 years from the year generating revenue, meeting one of the following conditions:
  - having at least 3,000 full-time employees or;
  - making at least VND 10,000 billion in revenue per year

- CIT exemption / deduction can apply for investments satisfying certain regulatory requirements on encouraged location and sector
- CIT exemption period: 2-4 years (beginning from first profit-making year or from the 4th revenue-generation year)
- CIT deduction (50%): 5-9 years (beginning after CIT exemption period)
- CIT deduction is computed on top of preferential CIT rate




### Onshore – Offshore Financing Structure



According to Clause 1 Article 6 Laws on Investment 2020, investments in the following 08 businesses are prohibited:

- 1 Trading of narcotic substances specified by laws
- 2 Trading of chemicals and minerals specified by laws
- 3 Trading of specimens of wild flora and fauna specified by laws
- 4 Prostitution
- 5 Human trafficking, trading of human tissues corpses, human organs and human fetuses
- 6 Businesses relating to asexual human reproduction
- 7 Trading of firecrackers
- 8 Debt collection services
