

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS GUIDE (FOR APPLICATION TO MIA PROGRAMME)

Application period: 1 August to 31 December



Online Application

Curriculum Vitae

- Job history in reverse chronological order (latest to earliest).
- List in bullet points core responsibilities at each job/role.
- Highlight key achievements at each job/role.
- Indicate academic records (Bachelor, Master, Diploma, etc).
- List down awards/scholarships received (if any).
- Capture the essence of 'leadership', 'passion for public service'.



GRE/GMAT/LSAT Test Score

- GRE/GMAT/LSAT test score.
- Register for the test at your nearest test centre.
- It is advisable to keep a min. of four months' preparation time ahead of the test date.



Official Academic Transcripts and Certificates

- All degree years' transcripts/ marksheets and degree scroll.
- If pursuing undergraduate degree at the time of application, please submit: 1) an unofficial degree transcript; and 2) a letter from university stating the expected date of graduation.
- The degree documents must be translated into English and notarised, if the original documents were in other languages.



Writing Sample

- Submit a writing sample of not more than 2000 words.
- A writing sample can be a work of fiction, newspaper article, or an analytical paper written by you to ascertain your writing skills for the MIA programme.
- You may choose the best sample of your writing from a previous submission during your undergraduate degree programme.



Three Reports of Reference

- Submit information of three reports of reference on the online application form.
- For applicants who have graduated within the last five years, at least one report should come from an academic referee who can attest to your scholarly abilities.
- If you are currently pursuing undergraduate degree, it is advisable for you to submit three academic referees.



Personal Statement

- Submit a personal statement of not more than 500 words.
- State your motivations for applying to the MIA programme and its relevance to your future career development.
