



EARLY DECISION PROGRAMME (EDP)

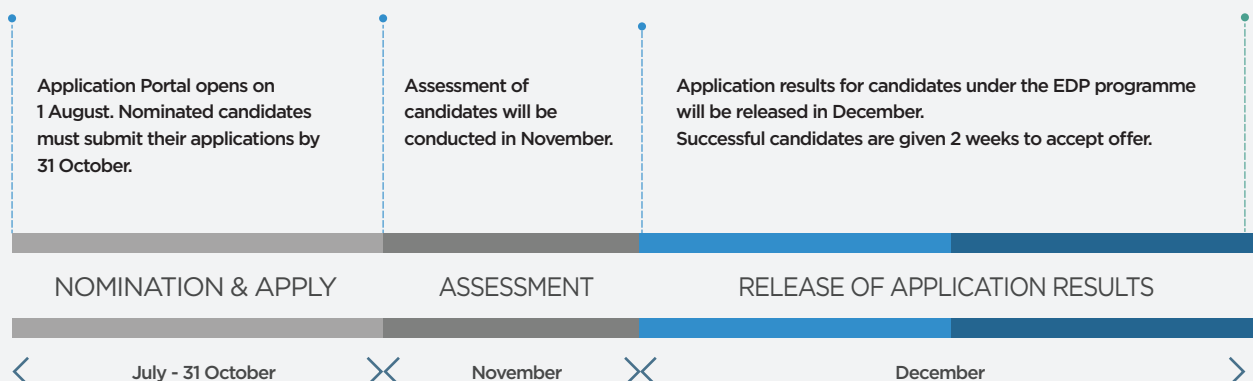
The Early Decision Programme (EDP) is a special programme exclusively designed for partner organisations. Both partner organisations and candidates from these partner organisations are provided time and resources from the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) to help them with their applications, resources planning, work handover and issues relating to personal commitments.

Candidates applying under the EDP must be fully sponsored by their nominating organisations. No scholarship(s) will be awarded from the LKYSPP.

Benefits

- Candidates from partner organisations receive assessment of their credentials prior to their application to LKYSPP's programmes.
- Candidates will receive 1-1 guidance from recruitment officers regarding their applications to LKYSPP.
- With early notification of admissions results, partner organisations will have ample time to plan for replacement resources, ensuring smooth work handover.

Curriculum Vitae

- Job history in reverse chronological order (latest to earliest).
- List down (in bullet points) key responsibilities at each job/role.
- Highlight key achievements at each job/role.
- Indicate academic records (Undergrad and Postgraduate Level only).
- List down awards/scholarships received (if any).
- Capture the essence of leadership and passion for public service.



TOEFL/IELTS Score

- TOEFL/IELTS is mandatory for all Master degree applicants, except those with a Bachelor or Master degree conducted entirely in English.
- Take the test (keeping a min. of three months' preparation time ahead of the test date).
- TOEFL IBT score report is available online 10 days after the test date. Hard copy score report arrives in 4 to 6 weeks after the test date.
- IELTS score report is available online 13 days after the test date.
- A score of 100 (TOEFL internet-based test), 600 (TOEFL paper-based test) or 7.0 (IELTS academic test), is preferred.



Official Academic Transcripts and Certificates

- All degree years' transcripts/marksheets and degree scroll.
- The degree documents must be translated into English and notarised, if the original documents were in other languages.
