# Festival of Ideas 2024 celebrates LKYSPP's milestone 20th anniversary

FOI 2024 brings together thought leaders across the public and private sectors from the government, academia, and the corporate world, to discuss today's challenges in Asia while charting a new course toward improved governance and sustained economic growth in the face of financial uncertainty, geopolitical tensions, and environmental changes.

Singapore, 16 September 2024 - The third biennial Festival of Ideas (FOI) 2024 will be held at Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) in Singapore from 16 to 20 September 2024 and coincides with the School's 20th anniversary.

The theme of FOI 2024 is "Navigating the World in Crisis: Transforming Governance through Ideas". The festival, inaugurated in 2019, will feature policymakers, prominent academics, corporate leaders, and government office holders, among others, engaged in 42 events such as dialogues and panel discussions, and hosting workshops and seminars, on topics on governance in areas such as geopolitics, economics, evolving technology, climate change, healthcare, and other social issues.

During this 5-day signature festival, the historic LKYSPP campus will be transformed into a dynamic hub of intellectual exchange to stimulate discussions that inspire solutions to some of the pressing policy issues of our time, while drawing out new ideas and possibilities. The goal is for FOI to increase the public's interest in policy and governance issues, and provide more avenues for meaningful engagement.
