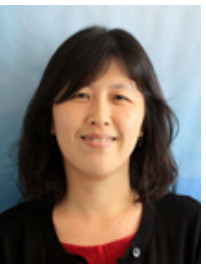
Paramita Dasgupta, Practice Manager, Trade & Competitiveness, Asia, The World Bank Group, Singapore
