## **Profile of our MPA Alumni**

**Yukihiro Shibuya, Social Development Specialist (Safeguards), Asian Development Bank, Manila Headquarters, Philippines**

Yukihiro is a Social Development Specialist working in the Central and West Asia Department within Asian Development Bank. His primary area of responsibility is supervising of social safeguards compliance particularly for land acquisition and resettlement issues in Azerbaijan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyz. Other areas of work include overall coordination and contribution to social safeguards policy, strategy and framework development, compliance monitoring, capacity building and knowledge sharing, staff supervision within department.

Prior to joining Asian Development Bank, for 13 years Yukihiro worked for Japan International Cooperation Agency (Tokyo, Japan and Phnom Penh, Cambodia), where he supervised projects on natural resources, environment and social safeguards in the Southeast Asian countries. In addition to the MPA degree from LKYSPP, Yukihiro holds Masters in Agricultural Science from University of Tsukuba, Japan.
