## TEACHING, DEVELOPMENT & CONSULTING WORK

Over the period of service since 1974, I have taught/lectured at the initial, professional development and postgraduate levels. I have, as Dean, overseen the development of NIE's BA (Education) and BSc (Education) and PGDE programmes. At the postgraduate level, I oversaw the development of the School of Education's Counselling, ICT and Leadership programmes. I currently teach on two master's programmes, one course for the Curriculum, Teaching and Learning Academic Group on the Singapore Curriculum and one course for the Policy and Leadership Studies Academic Group on Globalisation and Education. In 2012, I will be teaching on Master of Teaching and NIE's own EdD programme.

When NIE set up the Centre for Pedagogy and Practice (CRPP) in 2003, I was instrumental in its establishment and worked with Professors Allan Luke and Peter Freebody in developing the research agenda. I have served as Head, CRPP and as Associate Dean, Office of Education Research. In 2011, I served as an Advisor on NIE's proposed Master of Teaching programme.

I have also served on several Ministry of Education committees since its reform initiatives started in 1997. I have been a consultant to MENDAKI and to SINDA and am currently Academic Advisor to SIM University's Teaching and Learning Centre and to the Singapore Teachers Union's consulting arm, EduCare. On behalf of NIE, I conceptualised and assisted in the establishment of the Emirates College for Advanced Education in Abu Dhabi, the Bahrain Teachers College at the University of Bahrain. I was also involved in establishing the Sampoerna School of Education in Jakarta.
