Commission Overview

This session will present some of the best case studies from the past six years' work of Metropolis Commission 4 on Urban Mobility. - ways of expanding mobility infrastructure to guarantee an equality of access for citizens to all aspects of urban life;
- partnerships and innovative funding schemes for expanding infrastructure and public transport systems beyond reliance on traditional tax bases; and
- implementing strategic methods for developing commercial transport and global distribution networks in sustainable city development.

This session is an opportunity to highlight the co-ordinated efforts of Metropolis cities and stakeholders to develop global benchmarks in the sustainable development and management of urban traffic and transport systems
