Associate Professor Chong Chia Yin is the Director of Clinical Quality and Patient Safety, Division of Medicine and senior consultant of the Infectious Disease service, Department of Paediatrics at KKH. She is chairman of the Ministry of Health (MOH) Expert Committee on Immunization, and also a member of MOH Expert committee on Bioterrorism threats, pandemic influenza, dengue and member of the Hospital Infection Control Committee.

She is also appointed adjunct associate professor at the National University of Singapore, Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine and at Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School. She is also clinical teacher at the Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Nanyang Technological University. She received the Singhealth Residency Outstanding Faculty Award Academic year 2016-2017. Her other awards include: National Day Long service award 2016.

In research, A/ Prof Chong has published more than 80 infectious disease articles including prevention of HIV transmission from mother to child, hand, foot and mouth disease (HFMD), adenovirus, Zika virus, pertussis outbreaks, pneumonia, vaccine-preventable infections and invasive pneumococcal disease. Her current research interests include: Influenza, HFMD, prevention of central-line associated bloodstream infections, hand hygiene, pneumonia, tuberculosis, group B streptococcus as well as infectious disease outbreaks.
