Geoffrey See is the Head of Identity at Trustingsocial, an AI startup that provides AI-based credit scoring and identity solutions to promote financial inclusion for over 1B+ customers in emerging markets in India, Vietnam, Indonesia, Philippines and Bangladesh. Geoffrey is also the Founder of Choson Exchange (www.chosonexchange.org), a Singapore- and Vietnam-based NGO that has trained over 2000 North Koreans on entrepreneurship and economic policy. He is a member of the World Economic Forum's Global Future Council on the Korean Peninsula and is an advisor on entrepreneurship to the Gaesong Industrial Park, an inter-Korean industrial SEZ. His work on Choson Exchange has been written up as a Harvard Business School case study which he helps teach to Harvard MBAs in a class on Global Capitalism. He has survived two near-death experiences in his work in North Korea. Geoffrey is a Kauffman Fellow in venture capital and is passionate about technologies for financial inclusion and data. He co-founded a co-working space business in Vietnam, and help established a securities exchange built on blockchain technology. Geoffrey graduated from Yale University and the Wharton School and was an exchange student at Tsinghua University.
