Joshua is the Founder and Managing Editor of GovInsider, a local publication that interviews government officials across the world about innovation and tech. They also run large-scale conferences with the United Nations to bring together Ministers, Governors and Mayors to share success stories and discuss the future of service delivery. Forbes Magazine described GovInsider as "basically one of the biggest government influencers you've never heard of". University College London named a scholarship programme the 'GovInsider Scholarship' in honour of the work that they do.

Last year, Chambers led a research project for the United Nations into public sector innovation in China, Japan, Korea and Singapore. He is also an Executive Education Fellow at the LKY School. He presents the Asia Insider view on SPH Radio's Money FM, and consults for some of the world's largest tech companies including Amazon, Google, Visa, Grab and Dassault.
