#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES**

Yishun Health is a network of medical institutions and health facilities under the National Healthcare Group in the north of Singapore. Yishun Health aims to transform and support the Yishun neighbourhoods as self-managed communities. Such communities are designed as ecosystems where services are developed in tandem with building the residents' capability and capacity for self-care. In these ecosystems, Yishun Health supports residents to manage their own health and to navigate the 'formal' healthcare system to access care at the right touchpoints, and at the lowest cost to self and system.

To do this, its Population Health and Community Transformation team emphasises and engages Yishun residents' 'informal' layers of social support – networks of family, neighbours and friends - whom residents can count on for managing their health and addressing social challenges. The team makes itself more visible and accessible at nodes in the community, close to where residents live, and it has since become a familiar face, whom the residents trust. Team members are familiar with the residents' needs, as well as their assets, aspirations, and how health relates to those aspirations. In such ecosystems, the hospital and its services form the 'last' layer of support - a safety net for residents during medical crises to assist them to return to a supportive community which continues with their care.

#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES**

**Pro Bono SG** is The Law Society of Singapore's access to justice charity. On 31 January 2023, Pro Bono SG launched its community lawyering initiative to provide integrated legal care to the most socially excluded through a heartland presence and by working hand in hand with community partners, including Family Service Centres, Social Service Offices and Social Service Agencies serving the same geographical location.

Operating out of a Community Law Centre hosted free of charge by Tian De Temple along Hougang Ave 5, the initiative leverages on the trust capital of community partners and a strong community network to bring legal services closer to those who need them the most. In the first 6 months of operations, the Community Law Centre served over 650 clients through legal consultations and representation and engaged over 400 social workers, with a high level of receptivity from social workers to having legal support integrated into their work, through multidisciplinary case review panels, referrals and training.
