- ❖ Based on the Census 2000 report, interlocking quotas between average monthly household income and age were developed.
- ❖ Only Singapore citizens were selected.

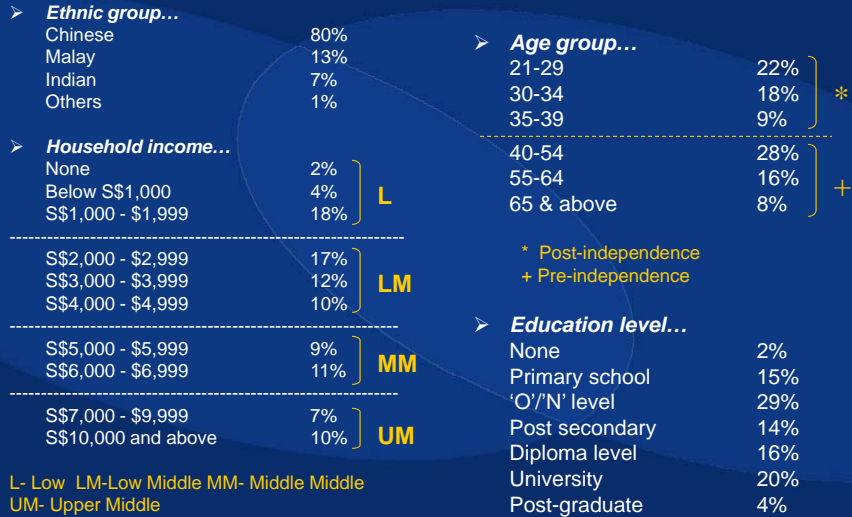

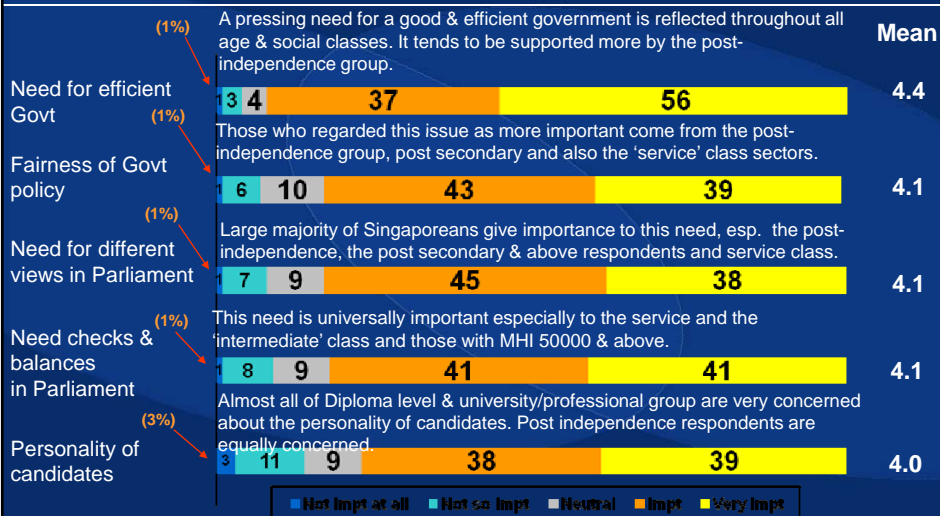

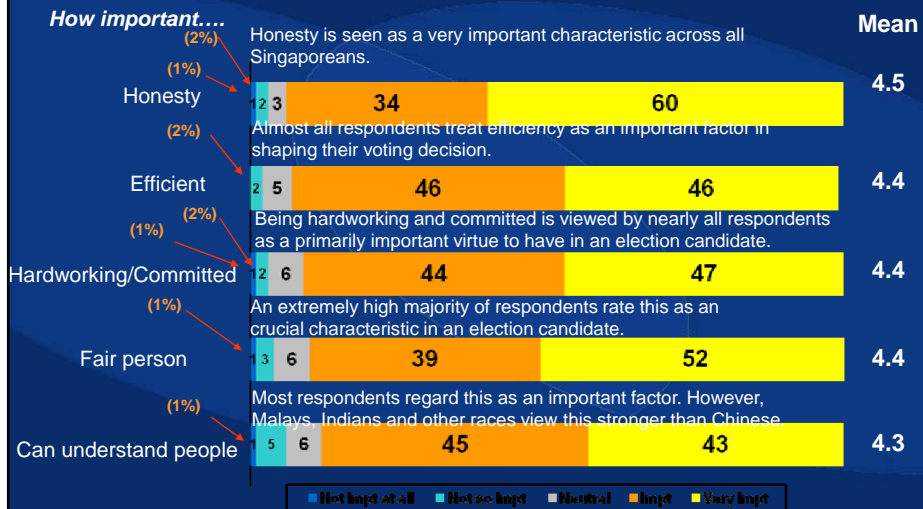

## Influence of Candidates' Characteristics

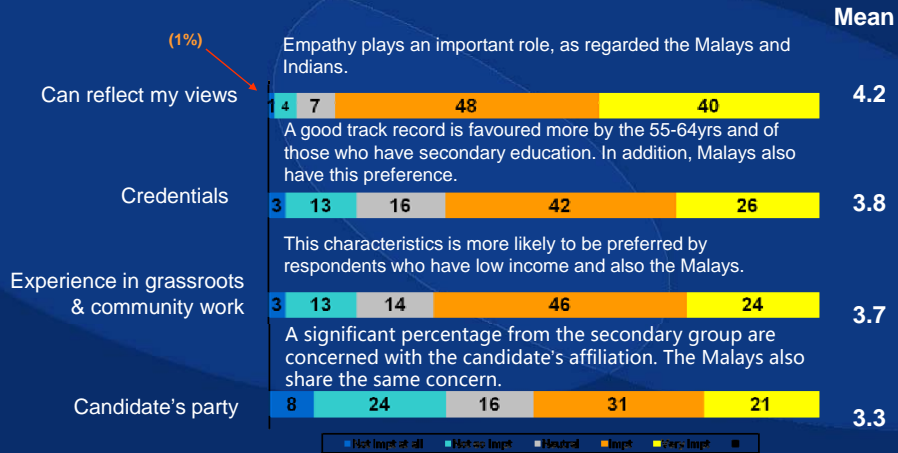

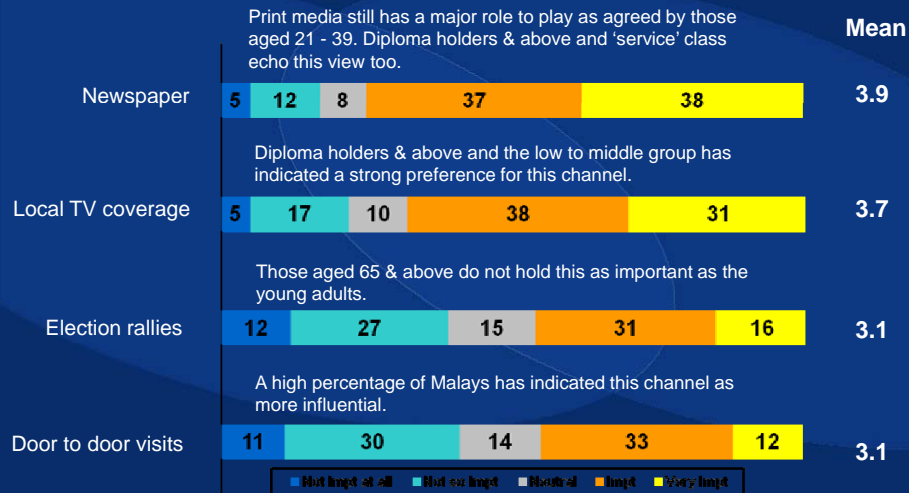

In shaping voting decision....

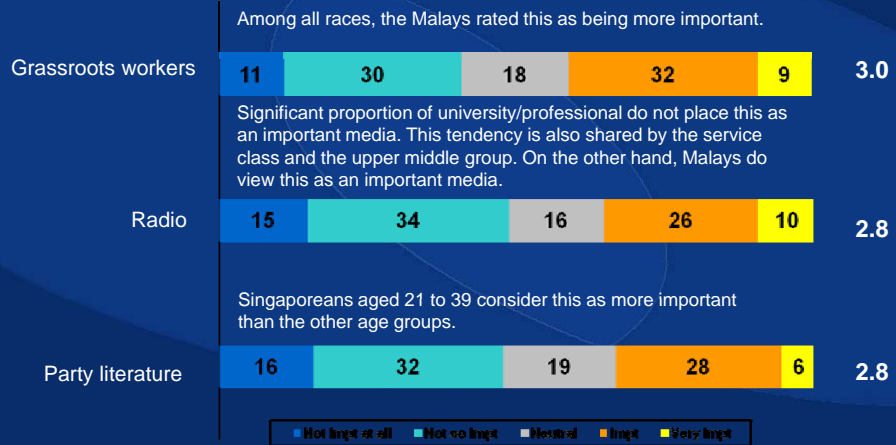

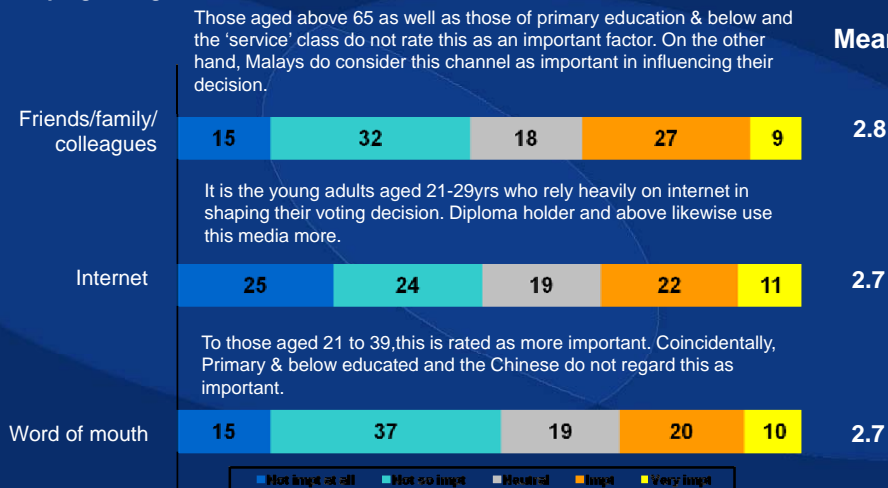

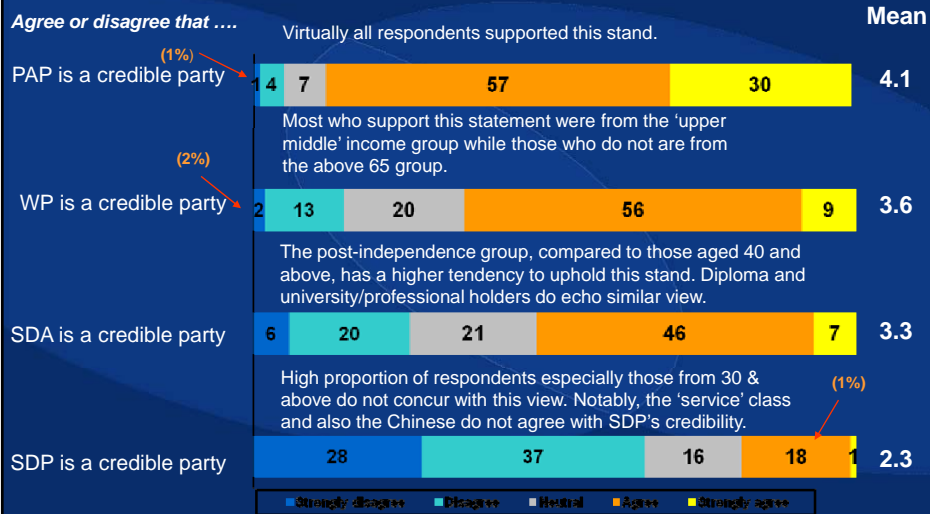

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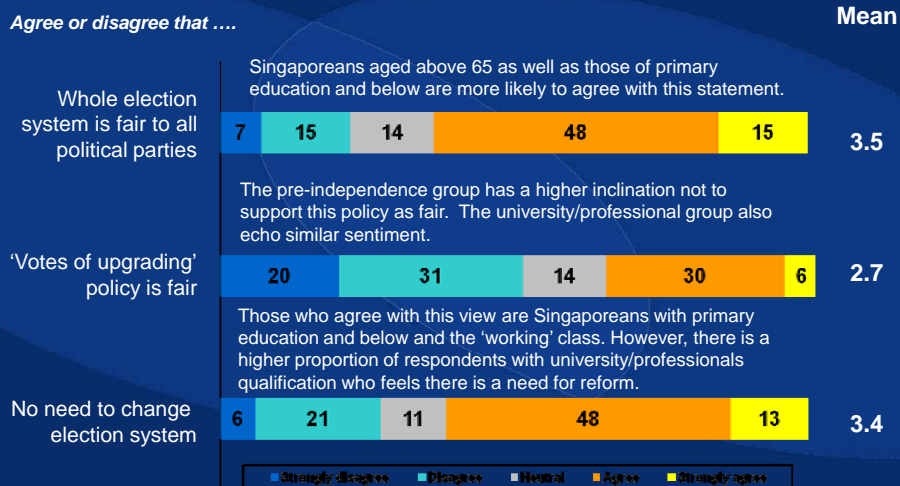
## Credibility of Political Parties



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## Views on Election System



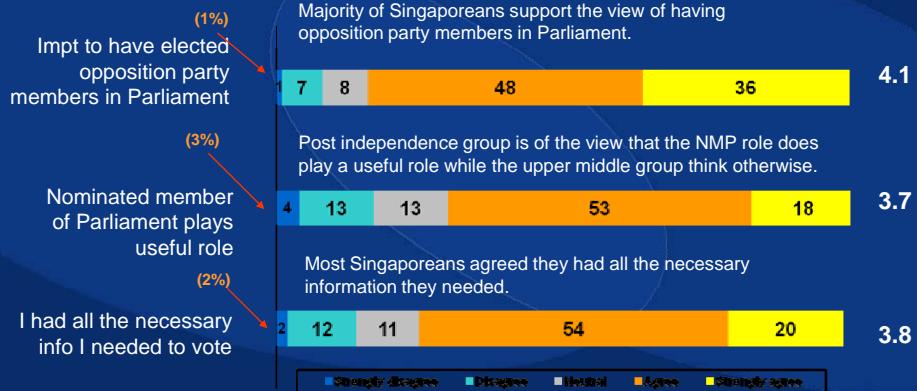

# Methodology

- ❖ Using t-test analysis and the mean scores, we examine each issue against age, social class, income, ethnicity and voter/non-voters.
- ❖ By doing this, we are able to look at which issue is more significant to which age or social class as compared to the other classes :

- ❖ To explain how to read the following charts: in the above, the mean score (4.50) of the Post-Independence group (A) on the importance of the 'need for an efficient government' is considered significantly different compared to the score of the Pre-independence group (B) (4.39) at the 0.05 level using this t-test analysis. Hence the letter (B) is placed next to the score for the Post-Independence group.
