#### The EU is struggling with many challenges:

- High unemployment
- Large job destruction
- Precarious employment
- Rise of structural unemployment
- NEET expanded young people not in education, employment and training
- Poverty and social exclusion
- Rise in in–work poverty
- Population ageing

Unemployment reaching 26 million and nearly 25% EU citizens at risk of poverty.

While workers' representation were more needed than ever, social dialogue and the rights of trade unions have been dismantled.





Reinforced involvement of the social partners on a European level, in view of the increased significance of the social policy measures of the European Union

#### TREATY OF LISBON

Entered into force on 1 December 2009 and is the latest of the Treaties which, to date, have amended the Treaties on the basis of which the communities and the European Union were founded. FADO ("destiny", "fate")

Fado - Lisbon song - was inscribed in the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage List on 27 November 2011.
