

HDB Resale Prices hits "crazy" prices

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Pinnacle @ Duxton flat sold for record S\$1,393 psf; most expensive price psf for HDB resale flat

It's getting harder to track record prices of HDB resale flats these days.

After the S\$1.5 million Tiong Bahru flat sale (axa the most expensive HDB resale flat) and the S\$1.42 million Toa Payoh flat sale (axa the most expensive 5-room HDB resale flat), we have another record HDB resale flat sale in the span of two months.

Recently, a 4-room Pinnacle @ Duxton flat was sold for \$\$1.41 million, making it the most expensive unit in the project. The transaction dethroned the previous record holders — a 5-room sold in March (registered in April according to HDB) and a 4-room sold in April this year — which changed hands for \$\$1.4 million.




In the wake of a historic high in HDB rentals for November, the trend appears to persist as HDB resale prices soar to new heights in December. This latest surge provides insights into the real estate market, shedding light on a dynamic landscape as the year closed.

December 2023 overview

As anticipated, HDB resale transaction volume experienced a minor dip of 6% towards the end of the year, influenced by the holiday season. Mr. Luqman Hakim, Chief Data & Analytics Officer at 99.co, notes, "This decrease aligns with the typical holiday slowdown we observe. However, we anticipate a resurgence in volume


Average Price for HDB Resale ~\$570k









