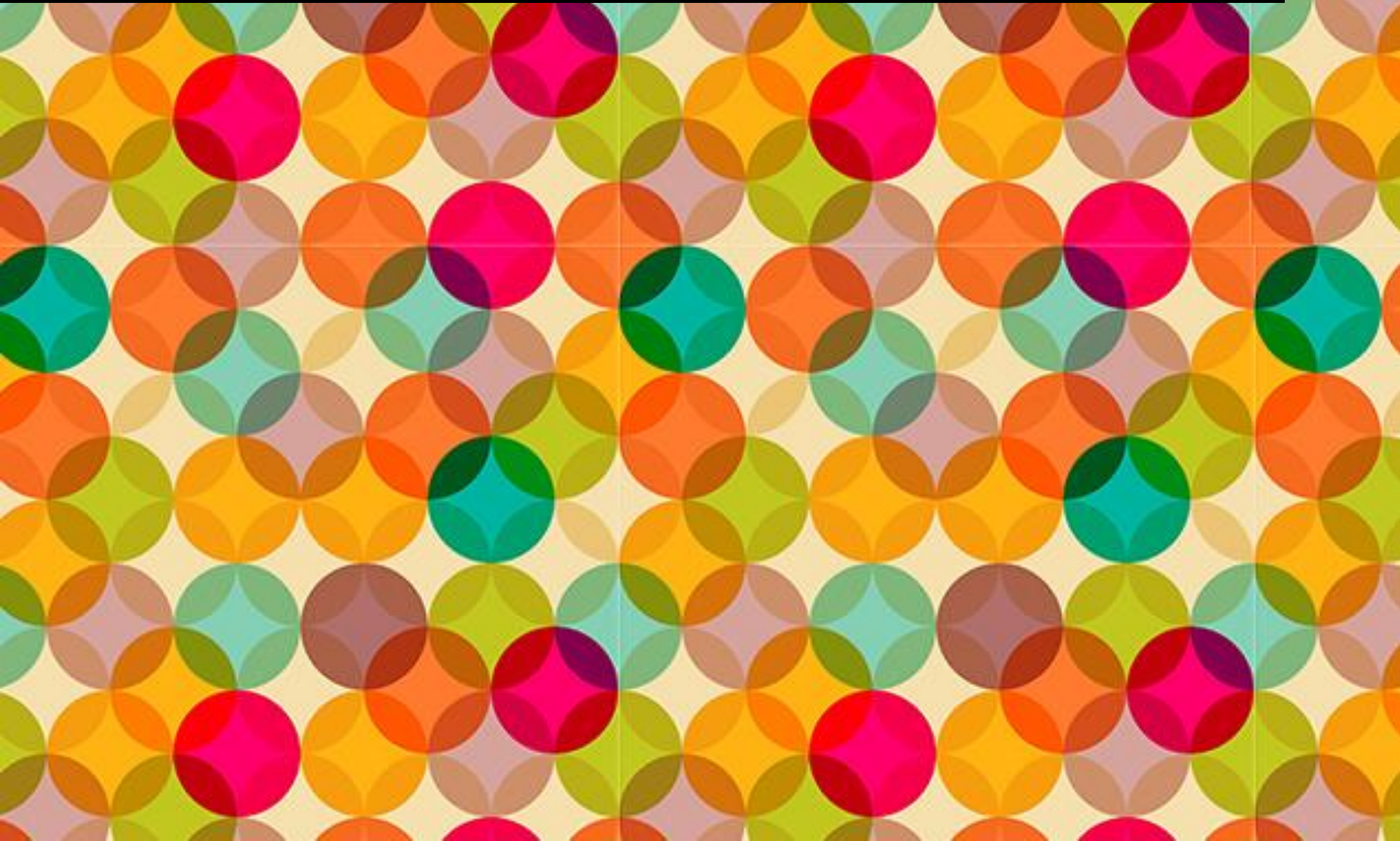

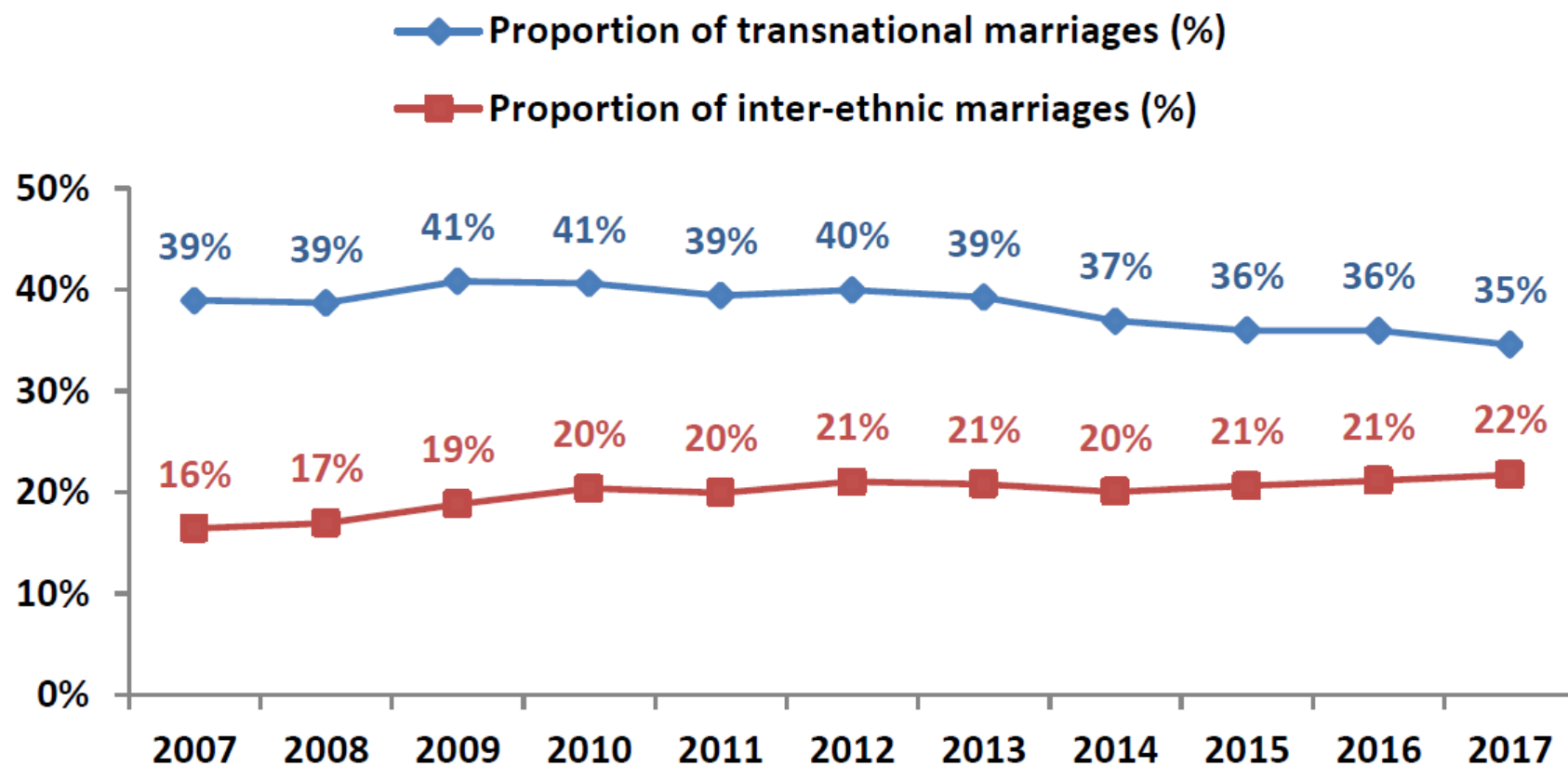

Note: Transnational marriages refer to marriages involving one citizen and one non-citizen (i.e. permanent resident or non-resident).

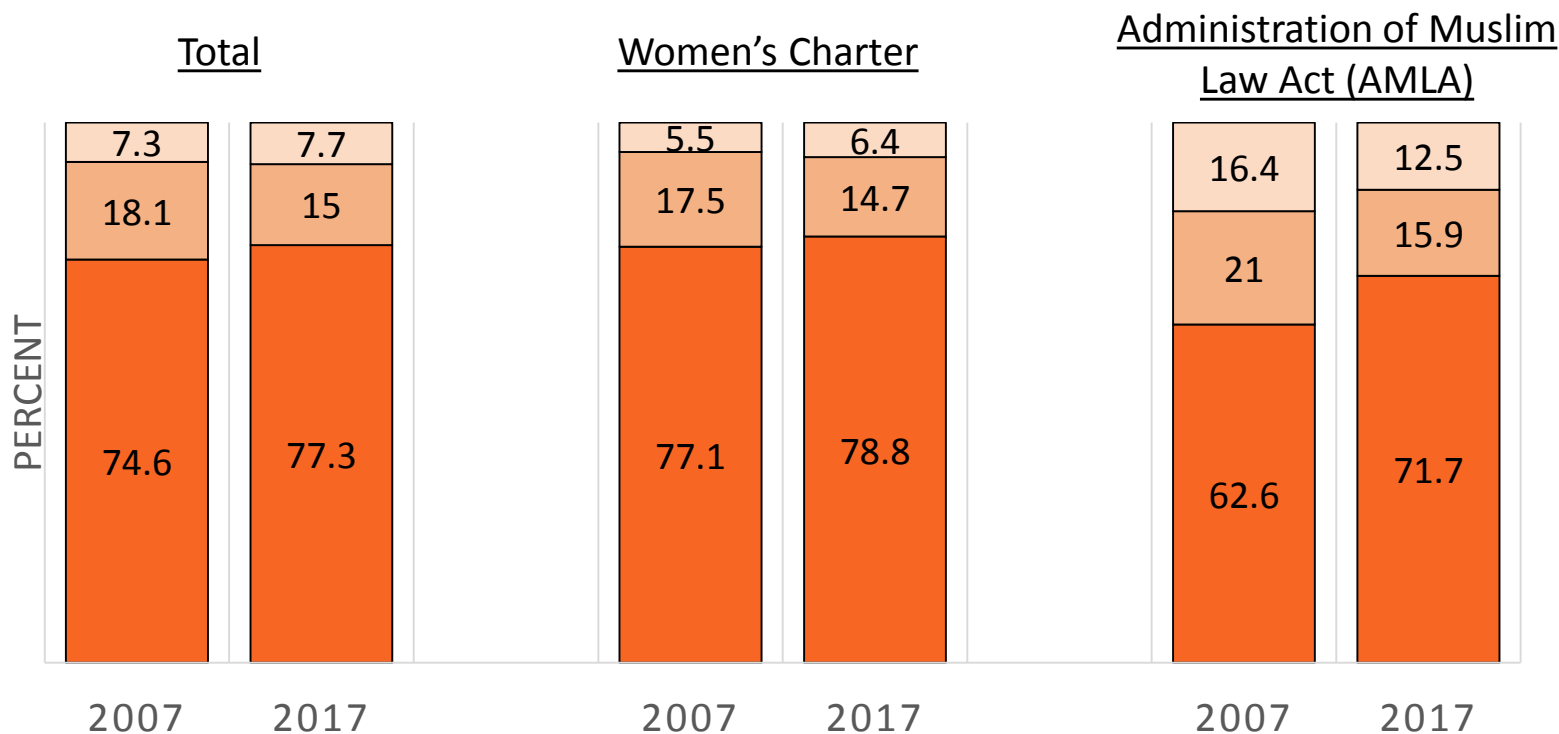
Family as a Source of Support

 ■ Remarriage, both partners

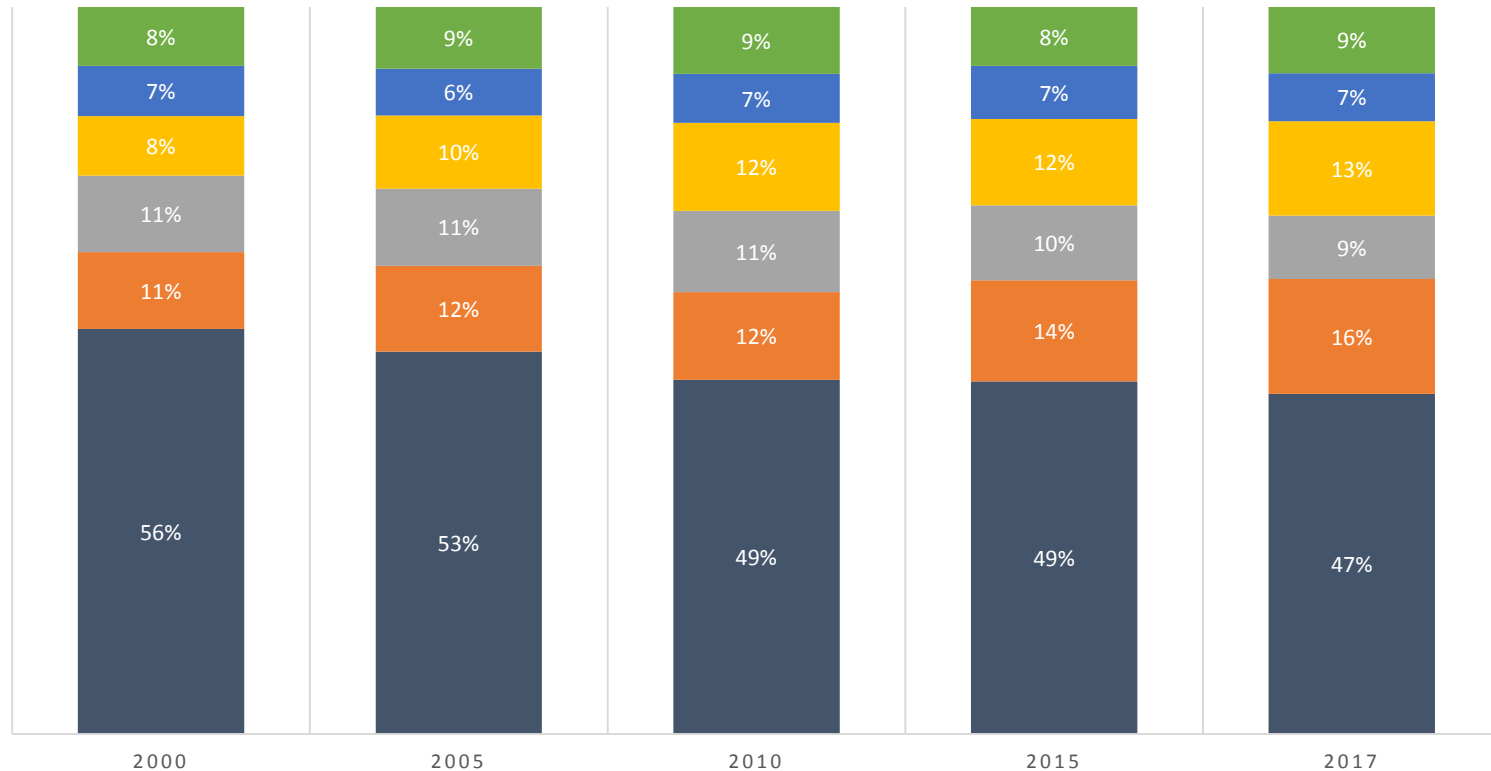
