## **Racisms**

- Colour Racism
- Anti-Semitism
- 'Paki-bashing', Anti-Asian, Anti-Arab
- 'Ethnic Cleansing' of Bosnian Muslims
- Not genetics but cultural/community
- = Cultural Racism (not a proxy)

#### Racialisation

- 3 key features
- i) Descent (not biological determinism)
- ii) 'Other'; 'All' or 'Most...'
- iii) A negative evaluation of the group
- = discourses, images, practices, institutions, including stereotyping or smearing individuals
- + Power to make it stick (+Capitalism)

#### Racism without 'Black'

- Racial dualism of 'Black-White'
- but:
- Cultural racism against Arabs
- Islamophobia
- Eastern European racisms (two-way)

#### Racism without 'Black-White'

- Eg. Arab antisemitism
- Eg. Islamophobia in India
- Eg. Ughyurs in China
- Eg. Sinophobia in Malaysia (cf. Indonesia)
- Eg. Christians in Pakistan
- Eg. Dalits in India, UK and USA (cf. MLK)
- Eg. Racial stratification in the Gulf
- Eg. Anti-Palestinian racism

## No Hierarchy of Racisms?

- No essential or inherent hierarchy of racisms
- But prioritisation based on scale of the problem, the number of people affected, the urgency of the problem etc
- -E.g., Exclusive Black Scholarships
- To not prioritise may be naïve or itself a sign of racism

## Decolonisation: second step aka 'Beyond EuroAmericancentricity'

- First step: seeing how the South has been dominated, shaped and misrecognised by the North
- Second step: seeing the South without the prism of the North, including internal South-South relations, antagonisms, empires and racisms (as well as positive contributions).
