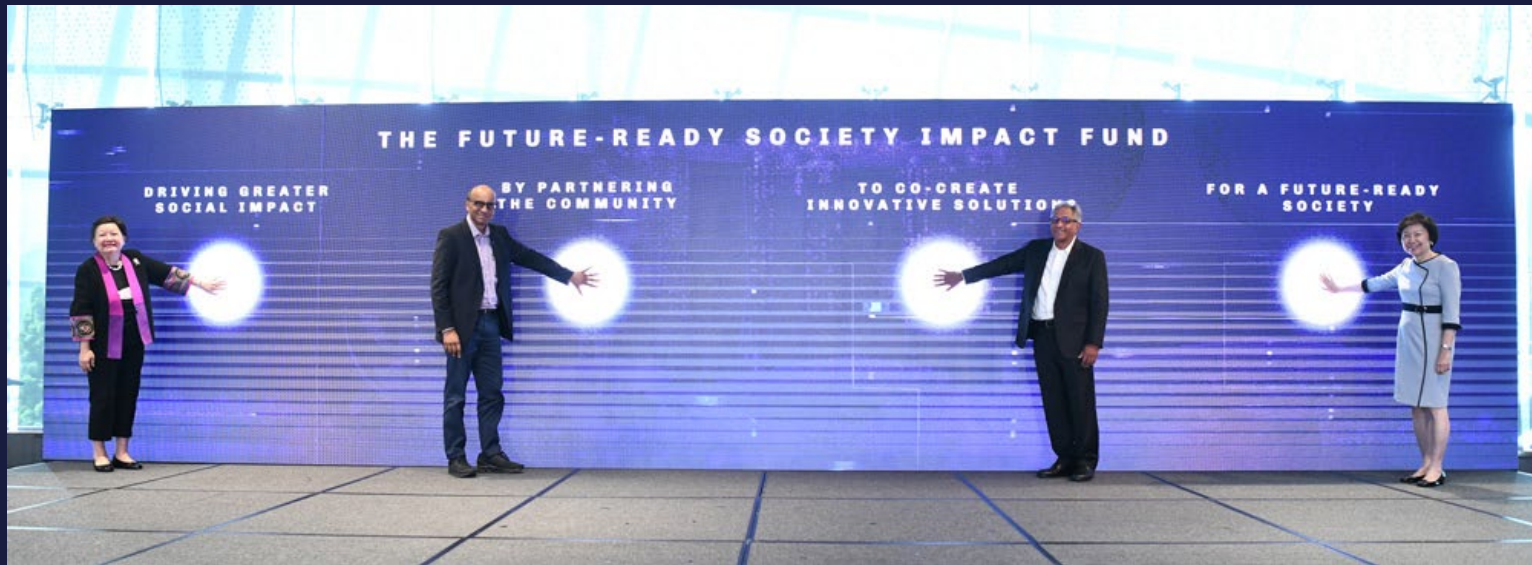

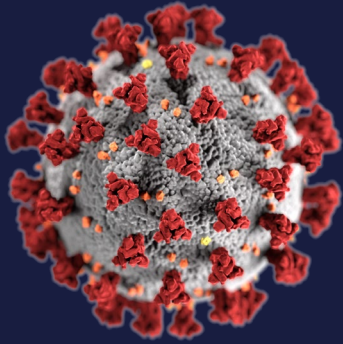

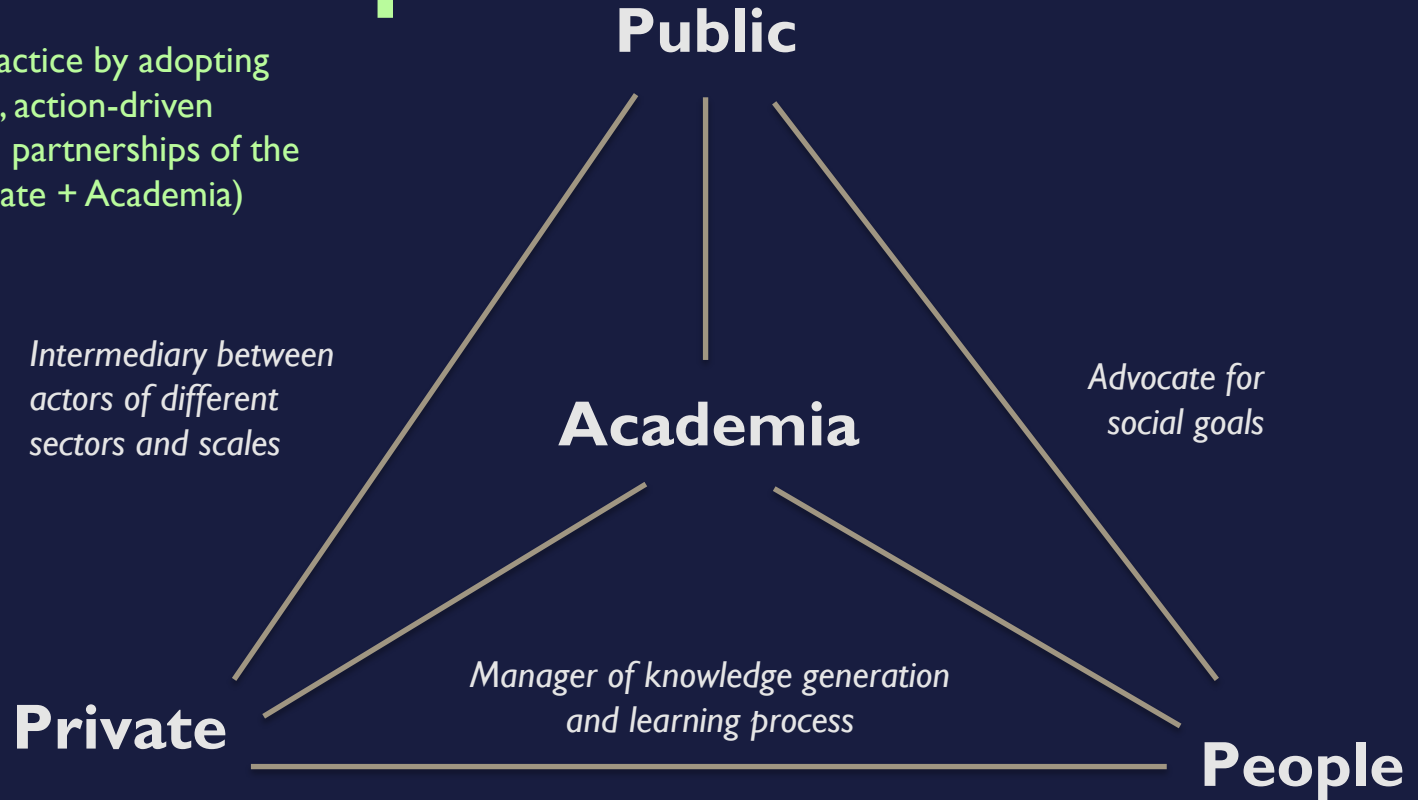


A future-ready society is one that is prepared for whatever the future has in store, be it forecasted or completely unpredictable.

Pre-implementation research of solutions, especially novel ones
[“experimentation with evidence”]

Action-driven research

Insights from on-the-ground solutioning further advance research and knowledge
[“learning by doing”]

Knowledge Partnership

Scan and identify issues that may affect the future well-being of our society;

Provide research insights and focus on the implications of these issues on human beings, behaviour and society;

Identify gaps and opportunities for intervention towards possible Impact Fund piloting;

Share knowledge with the broader community, to percolate futures insights, drive generative conversations, build capacities and enhance capabilities

Impact Fund

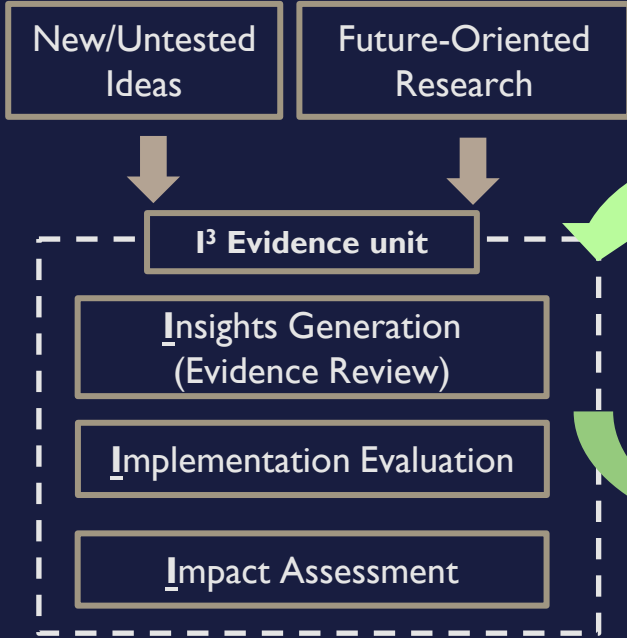
Pilot innovative solutions that have the potential to positively transform Singapore's social ecosystem;

To be future-ready, solutions should be novel, bold, and ahead of its time. This may necessitate re-thinking and challenging current beliefs and paradigms;

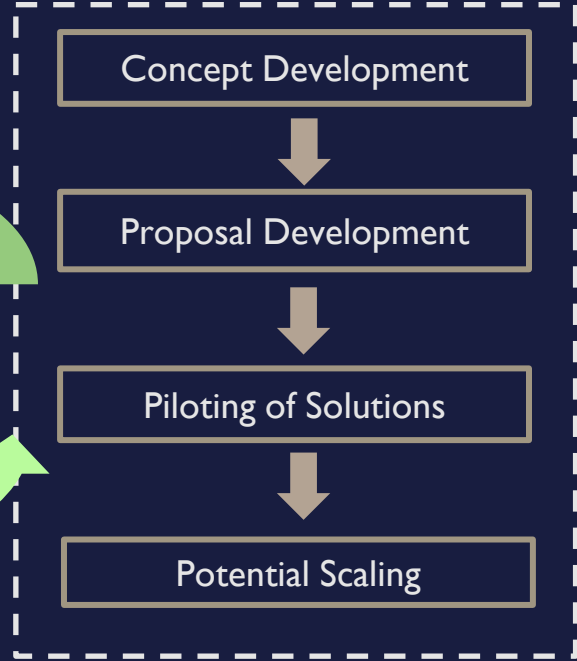
Engaging community partners to co-own issues, co-solution and co-drive the pilots;

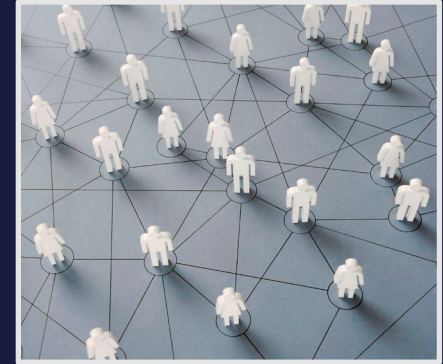
Investigates the use of eco-social creative collaboration to foster care for nature, encourage sustainable community practices and strengthen community identity

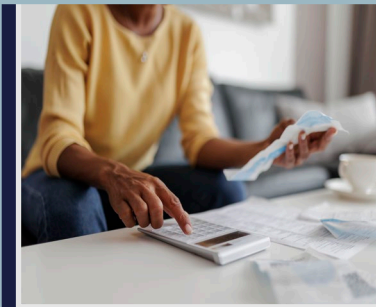
