

  - + Curriculum based on **Human Rights**






### **School Circles**


## **Democracy & Sociocracy**

**<u>Demo</u>cracy:** demos (people)+ kratos (power)

= power of the people


**Sociocracy:** socius (companions)+ kratos (power)

= power of the companions



**Democracy** (commonly): majority rule

Sociocracy: consent of all members






# **History of Sociocracy**

- Auguste Comte (1851): Sociocracy and sociology
- Kees Boeke & Betty Cadbury (1926): The Werkplaats School
- Gerard Endenburg (1960's): Sociocratic Circle Method (SCM)







# **Sociocracy Principles**

- 1. **Consent** no objections
- 2. Circle group with aim and domain, using rounds and consent
- 3. Sociocratic Election open election of roles using consent
- 4. Double Link feedback and communication between circles










### Consent

# **Sociocracy Decision Making Process**

### 1. Picture forming

Identify elements of the issue

## 2. Proposal shaping

Generate ideas and tune proposal

#### 3. Consent

3 rounds: questions, opinions & consent




# **Conflict Mediation Circle**




### Circle


- Circle: group of people who make consent decisions and work together
  - Domain: area of responsibility & activity
  - Aim: what the circle does or produces
- Rounds (circle process)
- 4 Roles: facilitator, admin, op. leader, representative





# **Circle Structure**

- **Circle:** area of responsibility (domain)
- Double link: operational leader (top-down) and representative (bottom-up)
















#### **School Council (Brazil)**
