About the study


- Period of Study: April 27th 8th May
- Nomination Day to a day after polling day
- 833 Blog posts examined
- 764 Blog posts coded & analyzed
- 200 blogs in total




About the study


- 10 coders split into 2 teams
- 1 team coding factual content
- 1 team coding qualitative content
- All coders undergone training on coding frame to establish familiarity
- All coders then underwent 1 round of coding tests using the same posts to establish reliability between coders




