ABU DHABI GOVERNMENT SIGNS MOU WITH LEE KUAN YEW SCHOOL OF PUBLIC POLICY TO ENHANCE COLLABORATION ON EXECUTIVE PROGRAMMES AND RESEARCH

30 October 2024, Singapore – A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed between Singapore’s Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP), National University of Singapore (NUS), and the Abu Dhabi Department of Government Enablement (DGE) to collaborate on executive education programmes.

LKYSPP will partner with DGE’s GovAcademy (DGE-GA) in the development of tailored Executive Education Programmes to be conducted in both Abu Dhabi and Singapore, as well as facilitate the exchange of expert speakers from both regions to foster the sharing of cross-cultural knowledge and expertise.

Francesco Mancini, Vice Dean (Executive Education) and Associate Professor in Practice, said: “LKYSPP will collaborate with DGE-GA on Executive Education programmes, focused on public policy, public management and good governance, for UAE/Abu Dhabi public officials, to improve their capacity to achieve their national vision amidst a challenging global environment.”

The MOU with LKYSPP is part of several MOUs signed between the Abu Dhabi government and various Singapore public and private partners during the official visit to Singapore by His Highness Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi, on 29-30 October.
