This course delves into the intricacies of policy design, focusing on the development of effective policies in the face of socio-economic and political challenges. Participants will enhance their theoretical understanding and practical skills for navigating the policy design process, particularly during crises. The curriculum addresses the political nature of policy problems, the essential capacities required for effective design, and the selection of appropriate policy instruments. Emphasis will be placed on integrating evaluation throughout the policy process to ensure robustness and adaptability. Key themes include the political foundations of policy design, the necessity of robust solutions for collective issues, and the interplay between policy instruments and implementation. Through discussions and hands-on working groups, participants will learn to approach policy design as both a conceptual framework

and a practical methodology for achieving governance objectives.
