Delivered as a collaboration between the Singapore Courts and the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, this programme addresses the core competencies essential for modern court leadership: ethical decision-making frameworks, strategic innovation, process improvement, technology governance and stakeholder communication. The programme features distinguished faculty from government, academia and the judiciary, delivered through interactive workshops, practical exercises and structured peer learning.

The programme provides applicable frameworks and builds a global professional network, enabling participants to drive meaningful improvements in their institutions.
